- * WVU NUTRITION HAS BEEN COMING IN FOR CLASSES WITH GRADES 3–5

– ATTENDANCE:

- * WORKING TOWARDS 95% ATTENDANCE RATE
- *TARDY TATER PROGRAM HAS SHOWN SUCCESS– BUT SCHOOL WAS HIT HARD DURING THE FLU SEAS

– SAFETY:

- * 2 FIRE DRILLS PER MONTH
- * ALL EMPLOYEES ARE ALICE TRAINED, WILL BE GOING OVER THIS WITH STUDENTS AND WILL HAVE DRILLS
- * 911 CENTER – WATCH CAMERAS AROUND COUNTY INCLUDING ONE ON THE TOWER AT THE SCHOOL– THEY CURRENTLY CHECK AND DOCUMENT EVERY HOUR DUE TO THE CONSTRUCTION AT SCHOOL

– BEHAVIOR:

- * LIVESCHOOL IS OUR NEW PBIS (POSITIVE BEHAVIOR INTERVENTION SUPPORT) PROGRAM– STUDENTS ARE RESPONSIVE TO THE PROGRAM. WE CLEARED OUT POINTS AT END OF SECOND QUARTER AND ALLOWED STUDENTS TO SHOP FOR FAMILY FROM SANTA'S WORKSHOP

– GOALS:

- * 100 STUDENTS ENROLLMENT IN THE NEXT 2 YEARS
 - MRS. DUNLAP CREATED BROCHURES TO DISTRIBUTE TO THE CHURCHES AND DURING COMMUNITY FISH FRY
 - YARD SIGNS “HOME OF A CARDINAL” WERE PURCHASED
 - THE ADDITION OF THE PK WILL HELP ENROLLMENT NUMBERS
- * MAINTAIN STATE TESTING TRAJECTORY

– SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION UPDATE:

- * CONSTRUCTION IS AHEAD OF SCHEDULE
- * CURRENT SCHOOL TRAILER WILL NEED TO BE MOVED BEFORE A SEPTIC SYSTEM CAN BE PUT INTO PLACE FOR THE NEW BUILDING
- * STUDENTS AND STAFF WILL BE AT THE COMMUNITY CENTER MAY 9–23 TO FINISH THE SCHOOL YEAR. COUNTY OFFICE IS WORKING ON CURRICULUM AND ACTIVITIES
